The Event Coordinator manages events from start to finish, ensuring they run smoothly and maximize the funds raised to support breast cancer research.

- Solicit and track event contributions from donors, sponsors, and strategic partners, ensuring all contributions are acknowledged in a timely manner
- Assist the Marketing & Communications Director with drafting and editing promotional event copy (for social media, local event calendars, press, event website, etc.)
- Proactively handle any arising issues and troubleshoot problems on the day of the event
- Evaluate event success and prepare reports and analysis for the President & CEO
- Establish and maintain relationships with vendors and venues and serve as main contact with throughout event process
- Other duties as needed to support the organization's mission
